



Gareth Gates is the Spirit in the Selsey Sky

Gareth Gates has been announced as a star name in Bunn Leisure's £1.5million entertainment programme for 2014 season in a line-up which will also include Strictly Come Dancing's Pasha Kovalev and Katya Vershalis.

Gareth Gates shot to fame when he finished as runner-up in the first series of Pop Idol in 2002. He quickly became a star when his single Unchained Melody entered the UK charts at number one and later went double-platinum. He went on to release several hits including Anyone of Us and Sprit in the Sky.



The pop icon landed the lead role as Joseph in the West End's Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat and also appeared in 25th Anniversary World Tour Les Miserables. This year the star is taking part in the final series of Dancing On Ice and the hit ITV2 show The Big Reunion, the pop star will unite with former pop stars Dane Bowers, Kenzie from Blazin' Squad, Kavana and Adam Rickitt to form boy band super group - 5th Story. He will be performing at Bunn Leisure's Embassy Club on June 14.

Strictly Come Dancing is coming to Selsey on April 19, when two of the show's top stars, Pasha Kovalev and Katya Vershalis, take to the stage to perform in front of an audience of 2,000 at Bunn Leisure's Embassy Club.
