Big gigs, top drawer performers and side-cracking comedians are lined up to perform in a star-studded new season at award-winning Bunn Leisure.

Get Outta My Dreams, Get Into My Car . . . and head down to the Selsey peninsula to see soul sensation **Billy Ocean** (*right*) perform live in concert at Bunn Leisure on May 25. The world-famous singer played to millions at LiveAid, had chart-topping hits Caribbean Queen and When the Going Gets Tough, the Tough Get Going and won a Grammy for his talent.



Drifting by Bunn Leisure will be the **Drifters**' lead singer **Ray Lewis** on March 29, who is back with a new tour and album. Ray will be recreating the great sound of Motown which made him famous, performing classic favourites such as Up on the Roof, Under the Boardwalk, Kissing in the Back Row and Saturday Night at the Movies.



Direct from the USA **Ben E. King** (*right*), who had a string of hits with The Drifters before becoming a solo artist and recording Stand By Me, will follow his former band member with a performance on September 7. He will star with Jimmy James & The Vagabonds and the Superstars of Soul.

Later in the season on October 5, **Alexander O'Neal** performs live in concert with his musicians. The American R&B singer, who is best known for his songs If You Were Here

Tonight, Criticize and Fake, plus his duets with Cherrelle including Saturday Love and Never Knew Love Like This, is welcomed to Bunn Leisure for the first time ever.

Straight from the set of Strictly Come Dancing, **Katya Virshilas and Pasha Kovalev** will wow the audience with their own sensational dance show on March 31. The dynamic duo will be showing all their best moves in a colourful, high-energy spectacular.


Nineties chart-topping powerhouse diva **Angie Brown** is back for an unforgettable night of hits on April 6. The vocalist, who's featured on tracks with Fatboy Slim, Lisa Stansfield and Bizarre Inc's Top Ten hit I'm Gonna Get You, will dazzle her fans at Bunn Leisure.

Irish International Platinum selling star **Rose-Marie** (*right*), who recently performed on BBC Radio 2's Weekend Wogan on St Patrick's Day, will be live in concert at Bunn Leisure on October 19. Rose-Marie, who was voted the most popular singer at the International Music Awards, turns her hand to country, Irish and the American Songbook for her popular show.

And English rock chart toppers **The Zombies** come to the holiday park with their hits She's Not There, Tell Her No and Time of the Season on May 4.

Head back to the Eighties with **Dennis Seaton** from **Musical Youth**, the British reggae boy band which reached Number One with its memorable Pass the Dutchie hit. He will perform a mix of soul, Motown and reggae in his performance at on October 19.

Finishing the season on November 2 are soul legends **The Stylistics**, who stayed at the top of the charts in the Seventies with a string of hits including You Are Everything and You Make Me Feel Brand New. They'll give an unmissable performance in their own sleek-suited style.



To keep the children happy, **Sid's Show from CBeebies** is full of songs, jokes, games and adventure on March 30. All the magic of Rainbow comes to the stage in **Rainbow Live!**, a fun show which brings back Zippy and George on October 26. Modern children's TV character favourites will also be making an appearance on 'Super Sunday Fundays' which include **Tree Fu Tom** on April 7, **Zingzillas** on June 2, **Mike the Knight** on August 4, **Rastamouse** on August 18 and **Moshi Monsters** featuring Poppet and Katsuma on October 27.

For the **best tribute acts**, see **Abba** Fever on May 5, Steve Littlewood & The HFH Band tribute to **Queen** on May 4, Lady Z & The Monsters tribute to **Lady Gaga** on May 24, Staying Live with the **Bee Gees** on August 9, Mainly **Madness** on August 24, Paul Hopkins as **Roy Orbison** on September 7, **Phil Collins'** ultimate tribute on October 26, Talon as **The Eagles** on August 31, Just Jessie as **Jessie J** on August 25, Michael King direct from the O2 as **Elvis** on June 29, Forever **Jackson** on August 25 and Bootleg **Blondie** on September 14.

Or if you're a wannabe star and want to be on stage yourself, then **Dream Factor** is your dream come true! If you can sing, dance, play an instrument or make an audience laugh, show what you've got in Bunn Leisure's very own talent contest on April 2, May 28, July 30 and August 27 and you could be coming back for the final.
