Brit Award-winning diva performs for one night only

An 80s icon who was the lead singer of one of the most successful bands of its time will be performing for one night only at a holiday park.

Denise Pearson, the voice of chart-topping group Five Star, will be taking to the stage at Bunn Leisure to perform a collection of the band's memorable hits.

The five-piece group of siblings from Romford followed in the footsteps of The Jackson 5 and went on to score a string of Top 10 hits, including "System Addict" (1986), "Can't Wait Another Minute" (1986), "Find the Time" (1986), "Rain or Shine" (1986), "Stay Out of My Life" (1987) and "The Slightest Touch" (1987).

The band, standing out for their flamboyant image and intricately choreographed dance routines, won the 1987 Brit Award for Best British Group and were nominated for a Grammy Award for Best R&B Instrumental Performance.

Denise will be performing at Bunn Leisure in Selsey, West Sussex, on Saturday, December 10 at the holiday park's Embassy venue.
