Five live at Bunn Leisure

One of the most popular boybands of the 1990s will be urging everyone to Keep On Movin' as they take centre stage at Selsey holiday park Bunn Leisure on August 10.

Ritchie Neville, Sean Conlon and Scott Robinson are three of the original members of Five, the hugely-successful boyband put together by the same management team that launched the career of the Spice Girls.



With hits like Everybody Get Up, When The Lights Go Out, Slam Dunk (Da Funk) and Let's Dance, the boys achieved record sales of 20 million worldwide – with 1.6 million albums and 2.1 million singles sold in the UK alone.

The band parted ways in 2001, but reunited in 2013 as part of The Big Reunion documentary series on ITV2, which was followed by a comeback arena tour around the UK and Ireland.

Five will be at The Embassy nightclub for the first time on August 10 – perfect for a last-minute camping trip at Warner Farm, where all entertainment is free to guests. A standard grass pitch costs from £80 for a two-night stay this August.
