Winner of BBC One's The Voice Kevin Simm to judge and perform at award-winning holiday park talent contest finale

Hot on the heels of the announcement that he will step into Marti Pellow's shoes as frontman of Scottish band Wet Wet Wet, Kevin Simm has been named as the guest celebrity judge of award-winning holiday park Bunn Leisure's glittering talent show finale on October 6.

The pop star, who won The Voice in 2016, joins the list of top names to have judged the talent show since it first started at the holiday park on the Selsey peninsula in 2014.

West End star Darren Day, X Factor judge Sinitta and X Factor winners Sam Bailey and Shayne Ward have all judged the Bunn Leisure's Got Talent final, which sees the lucky winner scooping a top prize of £1,000.

Kevin Simm, from Lancashire, first found fame on the ITV talent show Popstars in 2001, after forming the group Liberty X with four other runner-up contestants.



The band notched up 20 consecutive top 10 singles and won a Brit Award for Best Single 2003 with Just A Little.

In 2016, Kevin returned to the limelight, wowing the judges and winning the BBC's singing talent show The Voice.

Just last week, he was named as the new frontman of Wet Wet Wet, taking over from Marti Pellow, who left the band last year.

The Scottish band have sold 15 million records worldwide and spent 15 weeks at the top of the charts with their hit single Love Is All Around.

On Saturday, October 6, Kevin will be judging the grand final at Bunn Leisure's largest venue, The Embassy, and will treat fans to a showstopping performance showcasing his soulful vocal talent.

Head of Entertainment Adrian Douthwaite said: "We're delighted to welcome Kevin Simm as a celebrity guest judge at the Bunn Leisure's Got Talent grand final this year.

"He is the ideal judge for our fabulous talent contest and we're thrilled that he will also be performing for us on the night."

The holiday park's popular competition runs every year, with last year seeing over 300 talented performers audition throughout the school holidays in a series of heats.

Each of the live heat holiday winners won a free weekend break for up to four people for the final – and this year, 11 acts will compete for the grand prize.

To be in with the chance of seeing Kevin Simm and all the BLGT finalists in action, book a last-minute break over the weekend of October 6 – and all entertainment is free to all Bunn Leisure guests and its Oasis Health & Leisure members.

Three-night breaks start from as little as £33 per person, based on six people sharing, or get three nights for the price of two, at Warner Farm Touring park, starting from as little as £25 per night per pitch.
