and endangered species, with hundreds of animals from giraffes and tigers to otters and penguins. A new £7.8 million Tropical House opened this Easter, and is home to colourful mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and fish.



When the day is done, head back to Bunn Leisure and watch as the vast open skies fill with stars. Happy campers all round!

This June, a seven-night summer special deal means up to four people can book a standard pitch for £120, saving £55, an electric pitch for £215, saving £50, and a service pitch for £265, saving £47.50. Prices include everything from free showers and loos to swimming pools, kids clubs up to 17 years, TV character visits, evening entertainment, and daytime activities.
